4.0 Reports

4.1 FWA

Rob Bowman reported that staff had completed the emergency silt removal in Governor's Channel and was successful. Material had been placed inside the seawall around the office building for the flood preparedness project. They are currently setting up operations at Grass Lake and have received a 10 year permit from the US Army Corps for both dredges.

The agency has 35 new 36X36 metal signs acquired through the Lake County Division of Transportation to be installed at the entrances to the major lakes, streams and the River.

The recent derecho caused a lot of tree damage along the Lakes and river. The water levels have been low due to a lack of inflow to keep up with the required outflow to provide water for Elgin and Aurora under a federal permit.

Trinski Island permit is on hold as they are waiting for the complete hydrologic study to be completed before issuing a permit. Homeowners' biggest fear is increased local flooding. Will be at least another 1-2 years before issued.

There is currently an active campaign about not using water balloons or dumping other debris in Lakes and River in Lake County.

The lakes are wide open as is the river.

6.2 System Speed Limits

The Agency is apprehensive to support any changes to the existing speed limits (or implementation where there are none) without overwhelming support from the public.

Tom Fernstrom spoke about the very real impact of the wakeboard boats in the lower river and the excessive erosion occurring. There was a suggestion to apply for no wake permits in the areas with the most damage and that the police cannot do anything at this time. It was also noted that the river has been extremely rough this year with low water and increased boat traffic as well as an increase in loud noisy vessels.

6.3 Clean Up 2021- Potential add IDNR Based Hunter Blinds

Rob Bowman stated that the discussion is ongoing with IDNR and they are hesitant to make participation mandatory.
