7.1 Executive Director

Executive Director reported that:

- Sticker sales were up in January.
- Agency staff is working well together.
- The Fox River summit is scheduled for March 11th and the FWA is participating.
- A Fox Waterway building project award will be presented by the APWA on March 2nd.
- Staff is still seeking a DCEO grant for \$550,000 to purchase an amphibious excavator.
- Work is still being done to acquire the \$300,000 grant for the Grass Island excavation project.

7.2 Advisory Committee Reports & Recommendations

Pat Smarto, Chairman, welcomed Don Schnurr to the Advisory Board. She reported that the FWA is now on Instagram and the committee is reviewing their By-Laws and the committee is focusing on public education regarding the Agency.

7.3 Field Superintendent Report

Field Superintendent Bowman reported as follows:

- Staff was completing removal of dredge material from the west cell of Coopers Farm-they are about 95% complete.
- Material is being moved from Halings Landing to the Wall Street property.
- The Wall Street road will be under construction early Spring.
- Equipment maintenance is ongoing.
- The DNR approved and issued the permit for the Coopers Farm embankment stabilization project.

8.1 Directors

- Director Haling will make calls to try and jump start the dirt sale marketing program.
- Director Stochl no report.
- Director Hettermann agrees with the advisory committee's goal of educating the public on the Agency's business, including dirt sales and using social media to do so.
- Director Allen agrees the Fox Waterway should be more visual at Waterway events.
 He hopes this heavy snow base will not create a large snow melt causing waterway issues.
- Director Meyer announced that the budget hearing will be conducted at the next meeting of the Agency in March and during the budget process he will be looking to discuss Joe Keller's salary.

Chairman Blake reported that they had a good meeting with representative Tom Weber and the Chairman emphasized that money is needed from the State to fund FWA waterway projects.
