

America's Boating Course is presented as a PUBLIC SERVICE by the America's Boating Club of Waukegan. The first two and one half sessions will include boat terminology, required equipment and regulations, boat handling, navigation rules, aids to navigation, emergency conditions, marine communications, water sport safety, trailering, PWC operation, and knot tying followed by a review and examination conducted the second half of the third session. This course is designed to present basic boating fundamentals useful to either novice or experienced boaters operating on either inland waterways or open water such as the Great Lakes. Individuals who satisfactorily complete this course, including the examination, will meet the requirements of the State of Illinois Boating Safety Education legislation.
